



## **2-mile walk from the top of the Long Mynd and back down through Carding Mill Valley to Church Stretton**

**The walk starts from the Shooting Box.**

Ask the driver to drop you off at Shooting Box - enjoy the views as the Shuttle climbs the Burway and crosses the Long Mynd.

From Shooting Box, walk along the Portway, a 5000 year old Ridgeway. Look out for the Bronze Age burial mound, before turning right to join Motts Road, which will lead you down into Carding Mill Valley. This is a stony footpath, so please take care. You will pass a number of small streams, which flow from the many springs found on the hillside.

At the fork in the footpath, continue straight ahead to get back to Carding Mill Valley and the National Trust tearooms. Or take the path to your right for a detour to Lightspout, a four metre high waterfall. Retrace your steps and continue down the footpath into Carding Mill Valley and Church Stretton.
